

## FLSD COVID-19 Re-Start Health & Safety Precautions:

- Student & Staff Face Covering Policy:  
Based on the Ohio Department of Health order and the ZMCHD guidance that everyone in a school building should wear a mask unless there are health or developmental reasons (must provide documentation from doctor or IEP team to be kept on file at building office)
- Student personal dividers (clear plastic dividers students can easily carry with them throughout the school day to sit on tables and desks in classrooms and meal locations) for ALL students
- Classroom dividers for each teacher (30"x 36" plexiglass)
- Hand sanitizer available in ALL classrooms, buses, & common areas in all facilities
- Restricted Visitor Policy  
Visitors must call the main office of the building and someone will assist them in making necessary arrangements. All face-to-face meetings should occur at the Board Office located at 360 Cedar St in Duncan Falls
- Modified schedules to allow better social distancing during student transitions
- Modified breakfast and lunch eating locations
- Assigned seats in all locations (bus, classrooms, & meal locations) as required by ZMCHD (Health Department)
- Modified custodial schedules to ensure regular disinfecting before, during, and after students arrive
- Electrostatic Sprayers utilized to enhance cleaning methods in buildings and buses
- Cleaning and filter replacement of HVAC systems in all buildings prior to re-start
- Signage added to buildings to reinforce social distancing and handwashing
- COVID-19 Charitable Screening agreement program with Genesis to help staff and students with medical guidance on symptoms and screenings at zero out-of-pocket expense

- FLSD's two nurses will work with students and staff on health & safety education including handwashing
- Modified arrival, dismissal, and recess procedures
- Enhanced cleaning protocols for playground equipment
- Remote learning option is offered in lieu of face-to-face instruction
- No facility-use indoor access for non-FLSD sponsored activities until further notice
- Utilization of outdoor learning activities to allow for better social distancing
- Building water fountains will not be used, students are encouraged to bring a full individual container/bottle of water each day and all buildings will have touchless water bottle refill stations available
