

1.24 APPOINTMENTS TO CAREER CENTER BOARD

The Board of Education appoints an individual to serve on the Mid-East Career and Technology Center (Career Center) board of education of which the Board is a participating district.

Beginning with terms expiring on and after September 29, 2013, all newly appointed board members shall be appointed in compliance with this policy.

Terms of office

The member of the Career Center board shall be appointed to serve a three-year term. The member may not hold office for a period of longer than two consecutive terms. Terms are considered consecutive unless separated by three or more years.

Composition of the board

The appointed member of the Career Center board shall be selected based on the diversity of the employers from the geographical region of the state in which the territory of the Career Center is located. Prior to making the appointment, the Board will consult with the Career Center in order to maintain diversity on the Career Center board.

Not less than three-fifths of the members of the Career Center board shall reside in or be employed within the territory of the Career Center board upon which the member serves. Prior to making the appointment, the Board shall consult with the Career Center in order to maintain the required three-fifths balance.

Qualification of members

Members appointed to the Career Center board shall have experience as chief financial officers, chief executive officers, human resources managers, or as other business, industry, or career counseling professionals and be qualified to discuss the labor needs of the region with respect to the regional economy. Members shall represent the perspectives of employers in the region served by the Career Center and be qualified to consider the state's workforce needs with an understanding of the skills, training, and education needed for current and future employment opportunities in the state. When a new Career Center board member is appointed, the Board will adopt a resolution acknowledging the board member's qualifications and compliance with this policy.

Coordination of Board Composition

The Superintendent will coordinate with the superintendent of the Career Center regarding the Career Center board composition required by state law and this policy to assist the Board in selecting a qualified appointee.
