

6.00 STUDENT POLICY GOALS

Students are the first concern of the Franklin Local School District, and must receive the primary attention of the Board and all staff members. To fulfill its obligation to students, the Board will strive to formulate sound policy and consider other matters related to students. A similar commitment is expected of all staff members. In pursuing this primary goal, each student shall be considered and treated with respect as an individual. One of the major tasks of the educational program shall be to assist each student in becoming responsible for determining his or her own learning purposes and the means for achieving them. Staff members shall work together to establish an environment conducive to the appropriate learning and achievement for each student through meeting the following goals regarding students:

- A. To provide an appropriate learning program for each student according to his or her specific background, capabilities, learning styles, interests, and aspirations.
- B. To protect and observe the legal rights of students.
- C. To enhance the self-image of each student through an appropriate learning environment.
- D. To provide an environment in which students can learn personal and civic responsibility for their actions through meaningful experiences as school citizens.
- E. To deal with students in matters of discipline in a reasonable and constructive manner.
- F. To provide for the safety, health, and welfare of students.
- G. To promote faithful attendance and good work.
