

6.28 USE OF TOBACCO BY STUDENTS

Health professionals have determined that the use of tobacco products can be detrimental to the health of both the user and non-user, and the Board of Education wishes to encourage good health practices among the students of the school district. Therefore, the Board prohibits the smoking, use, or possession of tobacco or tobacco substitutes of any kind, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, chewing tobacco, snuff, or any other matter or substances that contain tobacco, in addition to papers used to roll cigarettes and/or the smoking of electronic, "vapor," or other substitute forms of cigarettes, clove cigarettes or other lighted smoking devices for burning tobacco or any other substance, by any student in any area under the control of the school district or at any school-related activity or event.

Violations will result in discipline pursuant to the Student Code of Conduct.

Disciplinary measures taken against students for violations of this policy will comply with the requirements of Ohio law and related school district policies.

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
