9.03 GRANTS FROM PRIVATE SOURCES

The Board of Education encourages the development of proposals to private foundations, governmental agencies, and other sources of financial aid for subsidizing such activities as innovative projects, feasibility studies, long-range planning, and research development. All such activities are to meet the following criteria:

A. Be based on a specific set of internal objectives that relate to the established goals and objectives of the District;

B. Provide measures for evaluating whether or not project objectives are being or have been achieved; and

C. The execution of all projects is to conform to state and federal laws and to the policies of the Board.

All grant proposals are to be approved by the Board or its designee before being submitted to the funding agency. The Superintendent may establish guidelines for the processing of proposal ideas to the Board for its approval.
