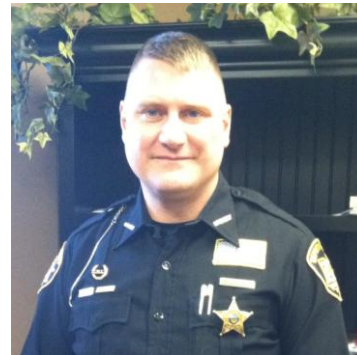

It is always a priority for the leadership of the Franklin Local School District to help keep the students and staff members safe while at school. For many years, a School Resource Officer has been assigned to our district on a part time basis. This year the Board of Education has provided two full-time School Resource Officers. Both SROs are Deputies with the Muskingum County Sheriff's Office. Deputy Brice Swiney is primarily assigned to Philo High School and Deputy Abbee Whiteman is primarily assigned to Philo Junior High School. Both have additional duties at Duncan Falls Elementary and help at Roseville Elementary and Franklin Local Community School when needed. Roseville Police Chief, Joey Carr, and the Roseville Police Department serve in a similar capacity for our Roseville schools.

At Philo High School, we are fortunate to have another helpful resource. Philo High School Industrial Technology Teacher Mr. Kevin Neal is also an Auxiliary Deputy with the Muskingum County Sheriff's Office. At the October 2018 Franklin Local School District Board of Education meeting, a resolution was passed that allows Kevin Neal to carry his firearm while performing his teaching duties.

In November, Mr. Neal will be wearing his Auxiliary Sheriff's Deputy uniform which includes his firearm. He will then transition to wearing a Muskingum County Sheriff's office polo type shirt. He will display his badge and will also carry his firearm holstered to his belt.

Kevin Neal is a trained law enforcement officer. We are very fortunate that he is also a Philo High School staff member. If there is ever a time at Philo High School when an individual is attempting to harm staff or students of Philo High School, Mr. Neal and our full time SRO Deputy Brice Swiney will now be present and equipped to help save lives.

I would like to thank Mr. Kevin Neal for his willingness to help keep the staff and students of Philo High School Safe.
